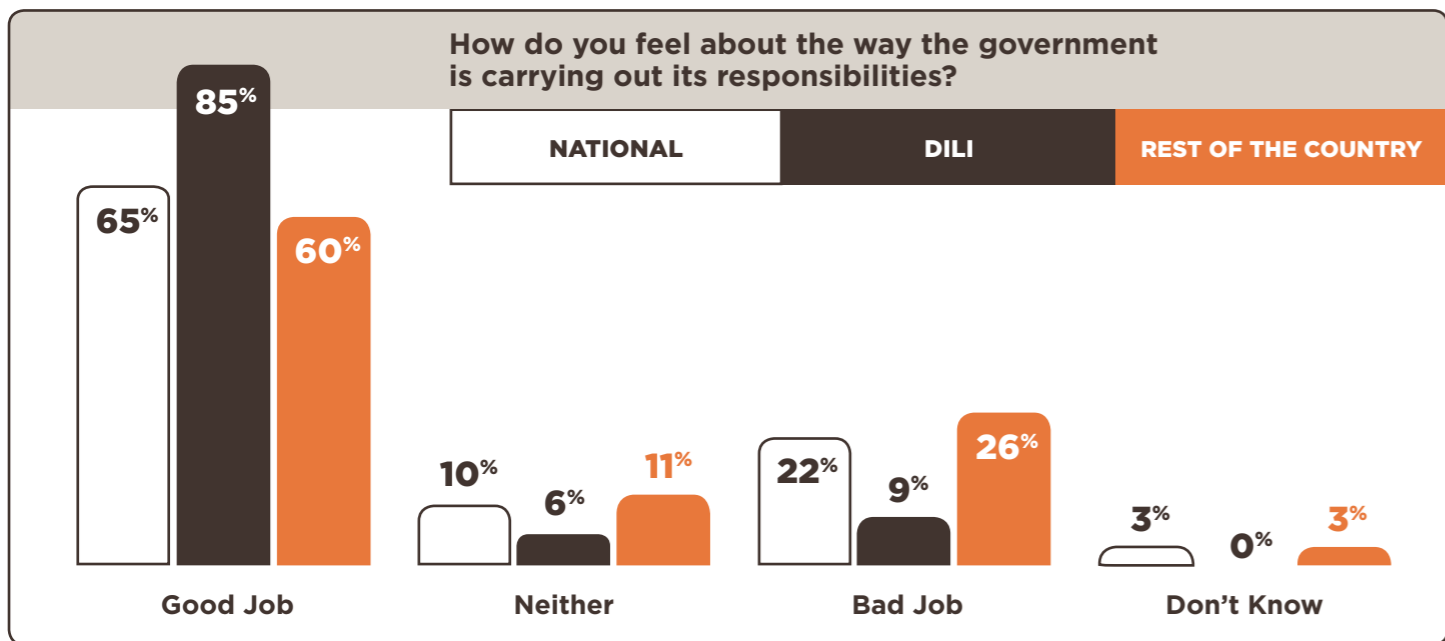
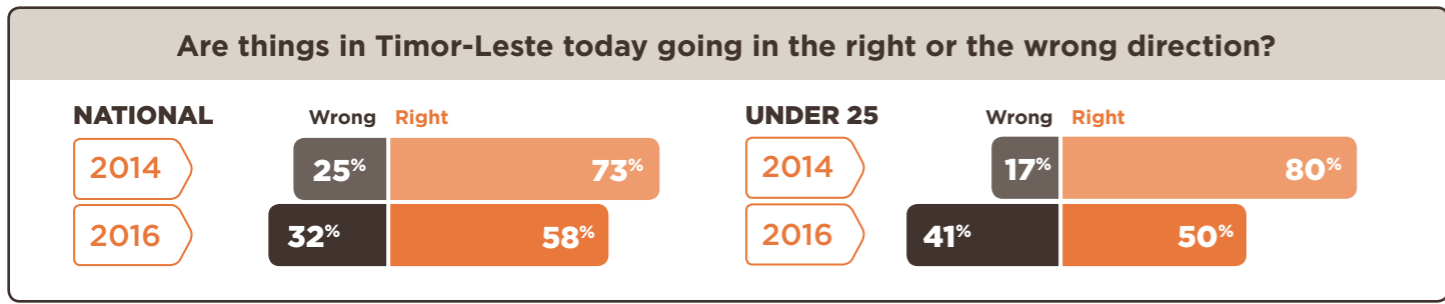

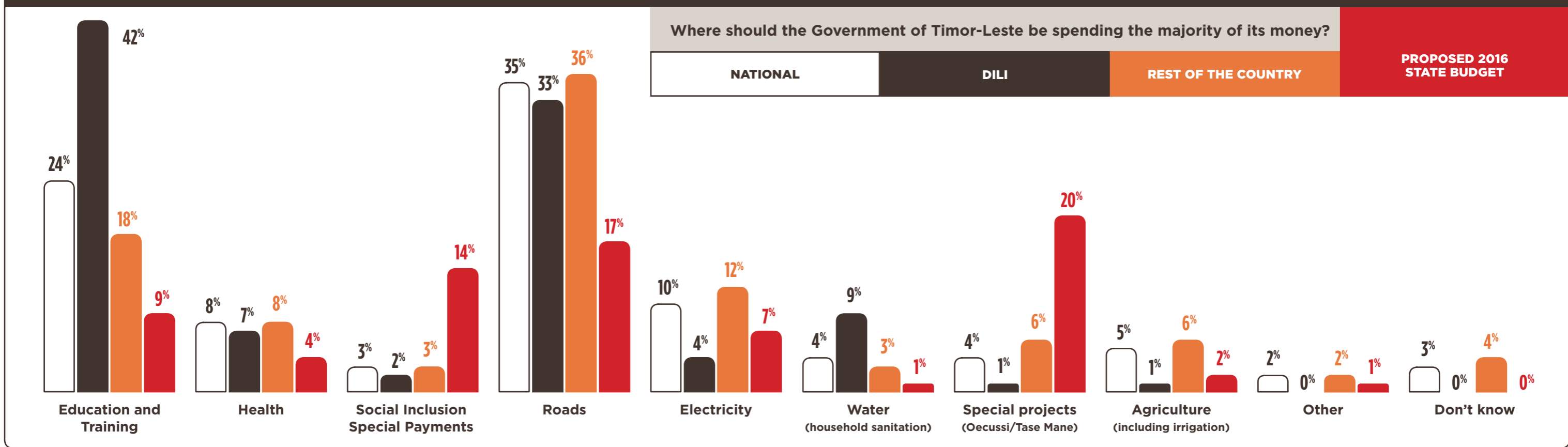
What are the biggest problems facing the people of your area?

Proportion of respondents employed in domestic work (raising family, caring for elderly/disabled individuals)



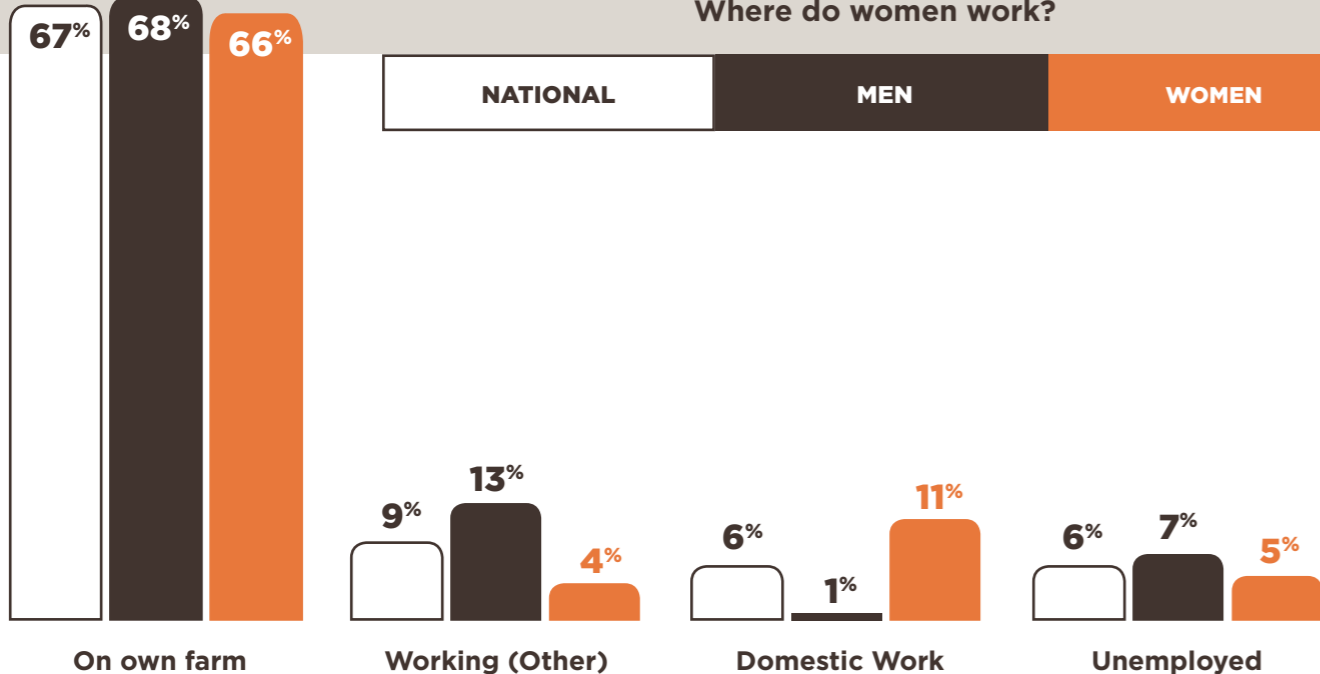
Should more women enter politics?

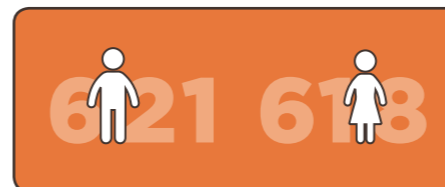
