- How did we change our technical and political course of action?
 - What did not work? What worked better? Could we have done things better?

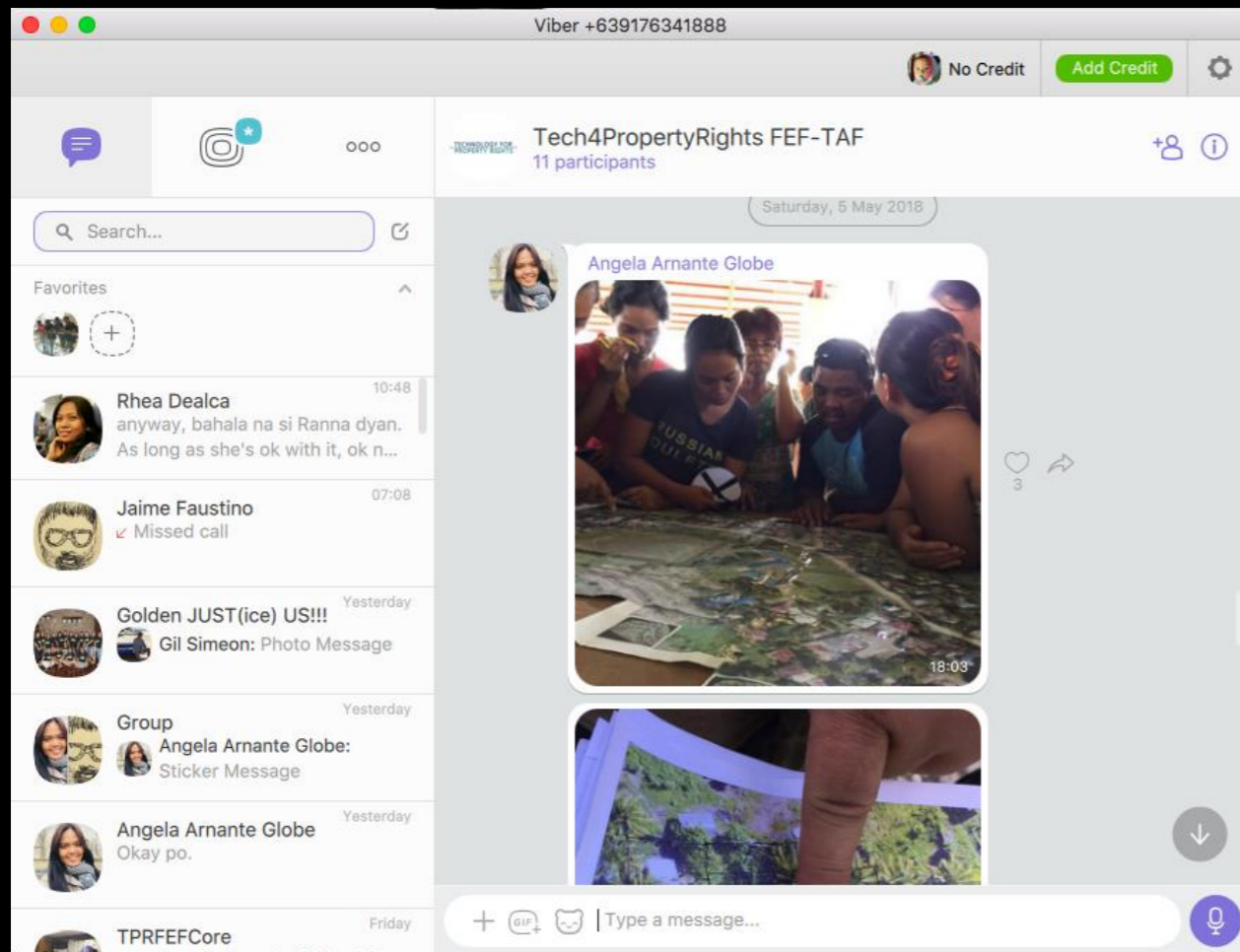
ATM Questions

- Does it confirm or question our political and transactional analysis?

Hi all,
We've set-up a meeting with AD Pacis and Engr. Warly. We wanted to:
1) know whether there is a need for PLA mobile. Sir Rene learned that LAMS is already accepting applications that are not yet complete--no application number yet. That is what we are doing in the PLA mobile right now. We might be duplicating things.
2) If yes, we can ask for LMB's support for its implementation probably via a policy or order.
3) If no, we'll have to rethink.
But the ultimate goal is to know where PLA mobile stands in the LAMS process.
The ideal is for LMB to say, "yes, we still need this. maybe you could revise it so it could fit more with LAMS. We'll support it and fund the training in the CMTs."
